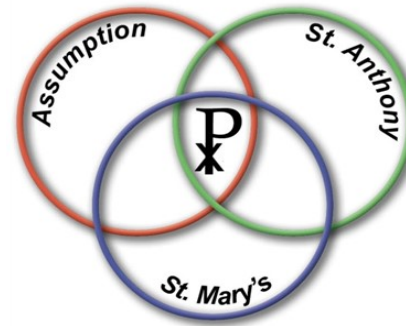

#### **Father's Corner . . .** Vocations Continued: **Discernment**

Turning to spiritual discernment, Pope Francis said this is "a process by which a person makes fundamental choices, in dialogue with the Lord and listening to the voice of the Spirit, starting with the choice of one's state in life". When Jesus, in the synagogue of Nazareth, reads the passage of the prophet Isaiah, he discerns the content of the mission for which he was sent, and presents it to those who awaited the Messiah: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." (Lk 4:18-19). He said the Christian vocation always has a prophetic dimension, since current events in a person's life and in the world must be examined "in the light of God's promise." "Every Christian ought to grow in the ability to "read within" his or her life, and to understand where and to what he or she is being called by the Lord, in order to carry on his mission," he said.

**Living one's vocation:** Pope Francis then added a note of urgency. "Vocation is today! The Christian mission is now," Jesus announces the newness of the present hour. The fullness of time has come, and he is the Messiah proclaimed by Isaiah and anointed to liberate prisoners, to restore sight to the blind and to proclaim the merciful love of God to every creature. Indeed, Jesus says that "today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing." (Lk 4:21)

"Each one of us is called – whether to the lay life in marriage, to the priestly life in the ordained ministry, or to a life of special consecration – in order to become a witness of the Lord, here and now." Everyone is called to live their vocation, the Pope said, and there is no reason to fear God's call, even to a life consecrated to God's kingdom. "It is beautiful – and a great grace – to be completely and forever consecrated to God and the service of our brothers and sisters."

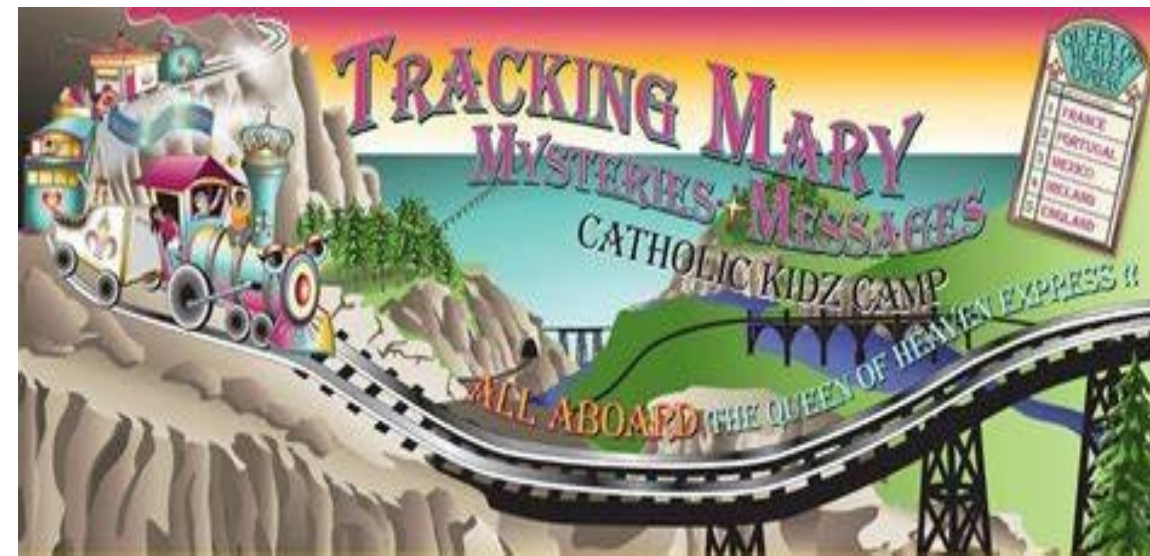
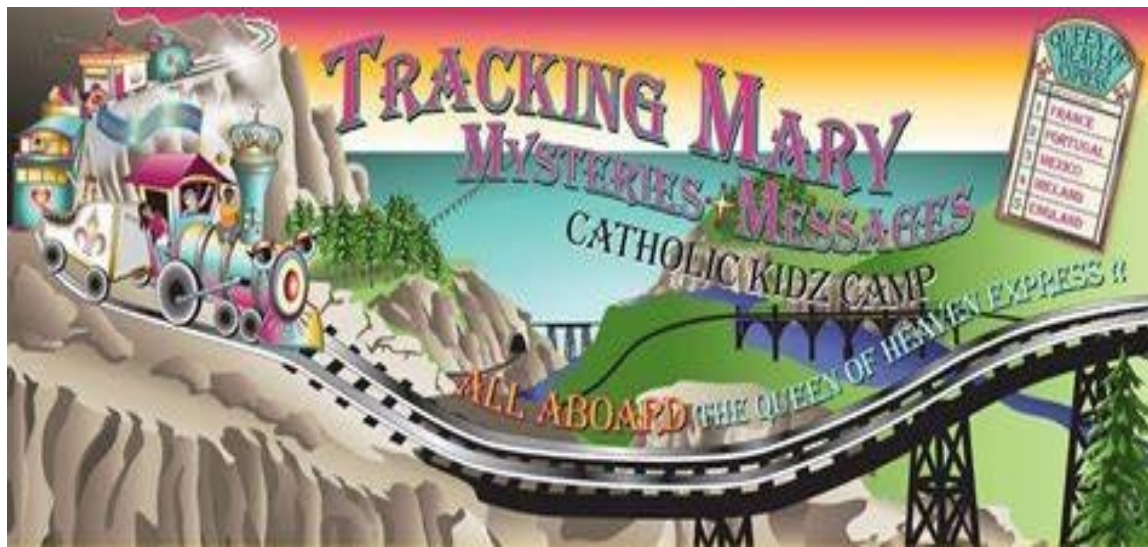
