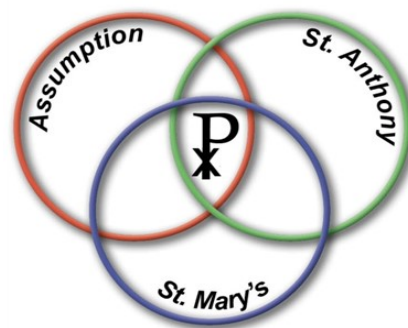

**Father's Corner :** The last two weeks on Salvation History now lead us to the question of "Why do we need to be saved and from what?" Generally speaking the concept of salvation involves three elements. 1) From what are we saved, 2) what are the means of salvation, 3) the state to be attained through salvation.

1) Why we need to be saved is sin. Both the inherited sinful condition of the human race and our own personal sins. We need to be reconciled with God. Revelation teaches that humanity was created in a state of right order toward God and our fellow creatures, and we ere destined to be elevated by divine order and grace to the eternal enjoyment of union with God in Heaven. However, due to sin this was all lost, so we need to be saved.

2 We are saved, reconciled with God, through Christ's actions – His Death and Resurrection- and the grace He gives us to both heal us and to enable us to begin the journey of salvation in which we are purified and transformed. This is the Good News! God out of love and mercy saved humanity. God works in history preparing humanity for their Savior. God the Son became human and saved us in His teaching, miracles, example, His Death, Resurrection and Ascension and by His establishment of the Church and by sending His Holy Spirit.

3 The goal we are aiming for is both union with God and our own flourishing. Christ restores us essentially to our original state. From being enemies, we are reconciled to God by the one Mediator. From spiritual death and disinheritance, we are reborn as children of God and heirs of heaven (Rom 8:17). Out of spiritual chaos we are recreated in the image of God by the Word of God. Christ freed us the bonds of sin and restored the goods of paradise – body immortality and unity with the Father.
