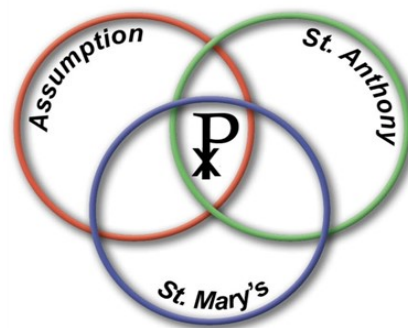

Father's Corner ... Creed Continued: (11) the resurrection of the body, Christ rose from the dead not just in spirit but body and soul.
